General Contractors until October 1, 2024, with certain modifications: To amend Section 34-8-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to clarify that performing routine landscape maintenance work on a public right-of-way, or not, does not require licensure by the board.

Replace line 27 on page 1 with the following:

Licensing Board for General Contractors until October 1, 2024, with the additional recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.

Replace lines 33 through 35 on page 2 with the following:

Section 3. Section 34-8-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

(a) For the purpose of this chapter, a "general contractor" is defined to be one who, for a fixed price, commission, fee, or wage undertakes to construct or superintend or engage in the construction, alteration, maintenance, repair,

25 rehabilitation, remediation, reclamation, or
26 demolition of any building, highway, sewer, structure,
27 site work, grading, paving or project or any
28 improvement in the State of Alabama where the cost of
29 the undertaking is fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or
30 more, shall be deemed and held to have engaged in the
31 business of general contracting in the State of
32 Alabama.

33 (b) For the purpose of this chapter, a "general
34 contractor" is defined to include one who, for a fixed
35 price, commission, fee, or wage exceeding five
36 thousand dollars (\$5,000), undertakes to construct,
37 superintend the construction of, repair, or renovate,
38 any swimming pool, and anyone who shall engage in the
39 construction, superintending of the construction,
40 repair, or renovation of any swimming pool in the
41 State of Alabama, where the cost of the undertaking
42 exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000), shall be
43 deemed and held to have engaged in the business of
44 general contracting in the State of Alabama and shall
45 be subject to this chapter.

46 (c) For the purpose of this chapter a "subcontractor"
47 is defined to be one who constructs, superintends, or
48 engages in the construction, alteration, maintenance,

49 repair, rehabilitation, remediation, reclamation, or
50 demolition of any building, highway, sewer, structure,
51 site work, grading, paving, or project or any
52 improvement in the State of Alabama where the cost of
53 the undertaking is fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) or
54 more under contract to general contractor as defined
55 in subsection (a) or another subcontractor.

56 (d) For the purposes of this chapter, neither a
57 "contractor" nor a "subcontractor" are defined to be
58 one who performs routine landscape maintenance,
59 whether on a public right-of-way, or not. For purposes
60 of this exemption, routine landscape maintenance
61 includes cutting grass; trimming, replacing, and
62 removal of bushes, shrubs, and similar items; the
63 placement and removal of pine straw, mulch, bark, and
64 similar ground covers; and other routine ground
65 maintenance."
