1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Barbour County; to provide further for the
4 compensation of the sheriff.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1.(a) Effective on the first day of the month
7 following the effective date of this act, the annual salary of
8 the Sheriff of Barbour County shall be increased by
9 twenty-nine thousand dollars (\$29,000) per year. The
10 additional compensation provided by this section shall be paid
11 from the general fund of the county in the same manner as the
12 salary of the sheriff is currently paid. Notwithstanding
13 subsection (b) of Section 45-3-230.40, Code of Alabama 1975,
14 the salary increase provided by this section shall be in
15 addition to any other compensation provided by law.

16 (b) In addition to any other compensation provided to
17 the sheriff, the sheriff shall be entitled to the same uniform
18 increases in compensation, including cost-of-living increases,
19 that are granted equally after the effective date of this act
20 to all county employees of Barbour County, notwithstanding any
21 provisions of Section 11-2A-4, Code of Alabama 1975, to the
22 contrary.

23 (c) This section is enacted pursuant to the provisions
24 of Constitutional Amendment 290 of the Constitution of Alabama
25 of 1901, now appearing as Section 2 of the Barbour County
26 Local Constitutional Amendments to the Official Recompilation
27 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

28 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first

29 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
30 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
