1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975,
4 those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during
5 the 2021 First Special Session, the 2021 Second Special
6 Session, the 2022 First Special Session, and the 2022 Regular
7 Session as contained in the 2022 Cumulative Supplements to
8 certain volumes of the code and 2023 Replacement Volumes 13,
9 13A, and 13B; and to adopt and incorporate into the Code of
10 Alabama 1975, the 2022 Cumulative Supplements to local law
11 volumes; to make corrections in certain volumes of the
12 cumulative supplements and replacement volumes; to specify
13 that this adoption and incorporation constitute a continuous
14 systematic codification of the entire Code of Alabama 1975,
15 and that this act is a law that adopts a code; to declare that
16 the Code Publisher has certified that it has discharged its
17 duties regarding the replacement volumes; to expressly provide
18 that this act does not affect any 2023 session statutes; and
19 to specify the duties of the Secretary of State regarding the
20 custody of the cumulative supplements and replacement
21 volumes.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of the
24 state enacted during the 2021 First Special Session, the 2021
25 Second Special Session, the 2022 First Special Session, and
26 the 2022 Regular Session as contained in the 2022 Cumulative
27 Supplements to Volumes 3 to 12B, and Volumes 14 to 22A,
28 inclusive, and the 2023 Replacement Volumes 13, 13A, and 13B,

29 and the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner
30 for editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson
31 Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2022
32 Cumulative Supplements and 2023 Replacement Volumes 13, 13A,
33 and 13B are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of
34 the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of
35 the volumes of the cumulative supplements and upon the first
36 inside page and the last inside page of the replacement
37 volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama
38 1975.

39 (b) The following corrections are made:

40 (1) Section 12-17-20, 2022 Cumulative Supplement to
41 Volume 11A, pages 3 and 4. To update the number of circuit
42 judges in the tenth judicial circuit and the twenty-third
43 judicial circuit to reflect the reallocation of a judgeship in
44 the tenth judicial circuit to the twenty-third judicial
45 circuit by the Judicial Resource Allocation Commission
46 pursuant to Section 12-9A-2, in subdivision (b)(8), replace
47 "27" with "26" in the first sentence and add the following
48 language at the end of subdivision (8): "Judgeship No. 14 has
49 been reallocated and will not be refilled." Further, in
50 subdivision (b)(20), replace "seven" with "eight"

51 (2) Section 32-5A-190.1, 2021 Replacement Volume 17A,
52 page 210. To revise an internal citation to reflect the
53 renumbering of the subdivisions and addition of new
54 subdivisions to that section by Acts 2018-286, 2019-437, and
55 2021-134, in subsection (a), replace "Section 32-1-1.1(81)"
56 with "Section 32-1-1.1"

57 (3) Section 45-51A-32.113, 2022 Cumulative Supplement
58 to Volume 22M, page 4. For grammatical purposes, in the first
59 sentence of paragraph (9)b., replace "a individual" with "an
60 individual"

61 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state
62 previously enacted and contained in the local and permanent
63 laws pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2021
64 First Special Session, the 2021 Second Special Session, the
65 2022 First Special Session, and the 2022 Regular Session, as
66 contained in the 2022 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 22B,
67 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 22J, 22K, 22L, and 22M and
68 the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner for
69 editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson
70 Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2022
71 Cumulative Supplement are identified and authenticated by the
72 Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and
73 back of each of the volumes of the cumulative supplements, are
74 adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

75 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
76 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act
77 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the
78 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the
79 Constitution of Alabama of 2022. This act is a law that adopts
80 a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Constitution of
81 Alabama of 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in
82 this act shall be deemed to codify any provision of law that
83 was adopted in violation of any provision of the Constitution
84 of Alabama of 2022, establishing requirements for, or

85 limitations on, the enactment of a law.

86 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as the
87 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its
88 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2023
89 Replacement Volumes 13, 13A, and 13B of the Code of Alabama
90 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes
91 with the material contained in the cumulative supplements
92 without making substantive changes, but making, under the
93 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code
94 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may
95 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of
96 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and
97 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and
98 misspellings.

99 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not repeal,
100 supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute
101 enacted into law during any 2023 session of the Legislature.

102 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, the
103 duly authenticated volumes of the 2022 Cumulative Supplements,
104 the 2023 Replacement Volumes 13, 13A, and 13B, and the 2022
105 Cumulative Supplements shall be transmitted to the Secretary
106 of State, who shall file the volumes of the supplements and
107 the replacement volumes in that office. The volumes of the
108 supplements and replacement volumes shall not be removed from
109 the office of the Secretary of State, but the Secretary of
110 State, upon request, under proper certificate and seal of that
111 office, shall certify any part or parts thereof upon payment
112 of the fee specified by law for similar services.

113 Section 7. This act shall become effective on the first
114 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
115 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
