1 Enrolled, An Act,

4 Relating to Opioid Addiction Treatment; to repeal the
5 Medication Assisted Treatment of Opioid Use Act of 2019,
6 codified as Sections 20-2-300 through 20-2-302, Code of
7 Alabama 1975, that provide for adoption of rules governing use
8 of buprenorphine in the treatment of opioid addiction and a
9 standing working group to assist in drafting the rules.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Sections 20-2-300 through 20-2-302, Code of
12 Alabama 1975, known as The Medication Assisted Treatment of
13 Opioid Use Act of 2019 and providing for the development and
14 adoption of rules by the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners,
15 with the consultation and assistance of a standing working
16 group, for the treatment of opioid-addicted individuals with
17 buprenorphine in a nonresidential setting, are repealed.

18 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
19 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
20 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
