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9	Relating to Cherokee County; to authorize the Cherokee
10	County Commission to levy and provide for the collection of an
11	additional vehicle license and registration fee on each
12	vehicle license and registration, transfer, or renewal of any
13	vehicle in the county; and to provide for distribution of the
14	proceeds from the fees to the sheriff and the district
15	attorney.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1.(a) The Cherokee County Commission may levy
18	and provide for the collection of an additional vehicle
19	license and registration issuance fee in the amount of three
20	dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75) on each new
21	registration, transfer, or renewal on any vehicle in the
22	county. The Revenue Commissioner of the county or other
23	license issuing officials shall collect the issuance fee on
24	each new registration, transfer, or renewal on a vehicle in
25	the county. The fee shall be in addition to all other fees,
26	taxes, and other charges provided for the license and
27	registration of a vehicle.
28	(b) The proceeds from the additional issuance fees upon

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- 29 collection shall be distributed on a monthly basis by the
- 30 Revenue Commissioner as follows:

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31 (1) One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) shall be 32 distributed to the District Attorney to be deposited in the 33 solicitor's fund. The proceeds from the fees shall be used for

law enforcement purposes and for the prosecution of crimes.

- 35 (2) Two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) shall be 36 distributed to the sheriff of the county to be deposited in 37 the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund. The proceeds from the fees 38 shall be used for law enforcement purposes.
- 39 (c) The proceeds from the fees and the use of the fees 40 shall not diminish or take the place of any other source of 41 funding of the District Attorney's office or sheriff's office 42 in the county.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
