SYNOPSIS:

Under the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, only the Governor may call the Legislature into a special session.

This bill would authorize members of the Legislature to request the convening of a special session with the Secretary of State, who, once he or she receives the requisite number of requests, would be required to poll all members of the Legislature. If a majority of members of both houses vote in the affirmative, the Secretary of State would notify the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, who would be required to issue a joint proclamation calling the Legislature into a special session.

Proposing to amend Section 76 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and add a new section to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the Legislature to call itself into a special session and provide for the process for

30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of

#### PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 76 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022 is amended to read as follows:

41 "Section 76

When the legislature shall be Legislature is convened in special session, there shall be no legislation upon subjects other than those designated in the proclamation—of the governor calling such—for the convening of the special session, except by a vote of two-thirds of each house. Special sessions shall be limited to 12 legislative days and thirty calendar days."

A new section is added to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022 to read as follows:

- (a) In addition to Section 122 of the constitution, the Legislature may also be convened in special session as provided in this section.
- (b) When 30 percent of the members of the Legislature request in writing the convening of the Legislature in a special session and submit the request to the Secretary of



57 State, the Secretary of State, within seven days after 58 receiving the requisite number of written requests, shall poll 59 members of the Legislature, and upon the affirmative vote of a 60 majority of the members of both houses, shall immediately notify the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker 61 of the House of Representatives. The President Pro Tempore of 62 63 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives 64 shall immediately issue a joint proclamation calling for the convening of a special session under the same conditions and 65 limitations in subsection (b) of Section 48.01 and Section 122 66 67 and shall set the time for convening the special session, which shall not be less than 14 days, nor more than 21 days 68 from the date of notification from the Secretary of State. 69

(c) If the Secretary of State fails to receive the requisite number of written requests to convene the Legislature in a special session within a period of 60 days after receipt of the first written request, all written requests received by the Secretary of State shall be rendered void and no special session shall be called. The written requests shall not be used at any future time for the convening of the Legislature.
