

10	enforcement agencies to collect fingerprints and DNA from any
11	illegal alien in the agency's custody and submit the
12	fingerprints and DNA for testing or cataloging.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. (a) Whenever a law enforcement agency in
15	this state has an illegal alien in its custody, the law
16	enforcement agency may not release the illegal alien until the
17	law enforcement agency has collected a full set of
18	fingerprints and a known DNA reference sample from the
19	individual.
20	(b) Following the collection of any fingerprints or DNA
21	pursuant to this section, a law enforcement agency shall
22	submit the fingerprints to the Alabama State Law Enforcement
23	Agency for cataloging and shall submit the known DNA reference
24	sample to the Alabama Department of Forensic Sciences for
25	analysis and entry into the appropriate databases.
26	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
27	following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
28	otherwise becoming law.
