SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, a juror receives mileage reimbursement of \$0.05 per mile traveled for court.

This bill would increase the mileage reimbursement to \$0.50 per mile.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to courts; to increase the mileage reimbursement paid to jurors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 12-19-210, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§12-19-210

~~(a)~~ Regular jurors, grand and petit, shall be entitled to ~~\$10.00~~ a ten dollar (\$10) expense allowance for each day's services, ~~\$.05~~ and fifty cents (\$0.50) for each mile traveled in going to and returning from court ~~and ferriage and plus~~ toll expenses, to be proved by the oath of the juror before the clerk of the court. The clerk shall give each juror a certificate, stating ~~therein~~ the number of days he or she has served, the number of miles ~~he has~~ traveled, the amount of

29 ~~ferriage and toll he has~~ tolls paid, and the amount of  
30 expense allowance to which he or she is entitled. The  
31 certificate shall be payable out of the State Treasury.

32 ~~(b) The provisions of this section shall be retroactive~~  
33 ~~to May 23, 1977."~~

34 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first  
35 day of the third month following its passage and approval by  
36 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
