SJR\_\_\_ MOURNING THE DEATH AND CELEBRATING THE LIFE OF  
OFFICER GARRETT COULTER CRUMBY.

WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the death on March 28, 2023, of Officer Garrett Coulter Crumby, of Huntsville and Tuscaloosa, Alabama, at the age of 36; and

WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the communities where he was highly regarded; and

WHEREAS, Officer Crumby was born in Starkville, Mississippi, on August 4, 1986, to William R. Crumby and Janet Sherman; he was their only son and the second oldest of four children; he was raised in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and was a 2004 graduate of Hillcrest High School; he was an outdoorsman who enjoyed kayaking, hiking, and storm spotting; and

WHEREAS, Officer Crumby began his law enforcement career with the Tuscaloosa Police Department as a patrol officer and field training officer; after seven years, in August 2020, he joined the Huntsville Police Department (HPD); in June 2022, Officer Crumby joined HPD's Bike Unit for the opportunity to combine his love for the outdoors with his desire to be more involved with his community; he hoped to become an investigator with the Financial Crimes Unit; and
