SJR___ CELEBRATING THE RETIREMENT OF CHIEF JIMMIE FLANAGAN.

WHEREAS, Chief Jimmie Flanagan served the State of Alabama in an exemplary manner as the Chief of Police for the Alabama Port Authority from January 2009 until May 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Port Authority Police Department is the third largest in Mobile County; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jimmie Flanagan joined the Alabama Port Authority as Assistant Chief in 2004 after a distinguished career in Alabama law enforcement leadership roles prior to his appointment, including, Chief of Police for the Elberta Police Department; Captain and Chief Investigator for the Foley Police Department; and Commander of the Patrol Division of the Gadsden Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Chief Flanagan's law enforcement career in Alabama spans a remarkable 50 years from patrolman to police chief; and

WHEREAS, prior to entering law enforcement, Chief Flanagan served his country with honor in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and, subsequently, as a member of the Alabama National Guard where he retired as First Sergeant of the 258th Chemical Battalion in Gadsden, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Chief Flanagan is a 1981 graduate of
