7	WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
8	passing of Marc Gann of Sylacauga, Alabama, and Samuel Adam
9	Russell of Hanover, Alabama, on April 2, 2023, during the
10	commission of a lifesaving effort; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Gann and Mr. Russell were dispatched to
12	rescue a hiker in Shelby County when the LifeSaver
13	helicopter crashed near the intersection of County Road 43
14	and Mountain Oaks Drive, tragically killing Mr. Gann at the
15	site and Mr. Russell passing later at the hospital; and
16	WHEREAS, Marc Gann, 63, served more than 20 years in
17	the United States Army as a helicopter pilot and as an Army
18	Ranger; he joined the LifeSaver crew in 2007; he worked with
19	the Oak Grove Volunteer Fire Department for seven years; Mr
20	Gann leaves behind his wife, Brenda; and three children,
21	Kelly, Craig, and Holly; and
22	WHEREAS, Samuel Adam Russell, 43, was a part-time
23	firefighter for the Sylacauga Fire Department for more than
24	15 years, as well as a paramedic and registered nurse with
25	LifeSaver; Mr. Russell leaves behind his wife, Tamara; and
26	sons, Dylan, JD Stephens, and Jesse Lankford; and
27	WHEREAS, although their presence will be greatly
28	missed, the memories of Mr. Gann and Mr. Russell will be
