26 half of the workforce of the United States and make up 99.7 27 percent of all employees in the United States; and 28 WHEREAS, small businesses produce one-third of the 29 exports of the United States and account for nearly half of private sector output, and Alabama small firms exported 30 31 goods worth over \$2 billion; and 32 WHEREAS, 9.1 percent of all small business owners 33 are veterans; and WHEREAS, women make up 47 percent of small business 34 workers and own 43 percent of small businesses; and 35 36 WHEREAS, two out of every three new jobs in the United States are created by small businesses; now 37 38 therefore,
