8 WHEREAS, highest commendations and congratulations 9 are proudly presented to Senator J.T. "Jabo" Waggoner with 10 sincere gratitude on the occasion of this historic 50th year 11 of his service to the Legislature of the State of Alabama; 12 and

13 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner is a Birmingham native and 14 a graduate of Ensley High School; he attended Auburn 15 University and was a walk-on to the basketball team; two 16 years later, he was awarded a basketball scholarship to 17 Birmingham-Southern College, transferred, and earned a 18 Bachelor's Degree; he earned his Juris Doctor from the 19 Birmingham School of Law; and

WHEREAS, at the age of 29, Senator Waggoner won a 20 21 seat in the Alabama House of Representatives and served from 22 1966 until 1983; he was Alabama's Sixth Congressional District Nominee in 1984; he served as the Governor's 23 24 legislative liaison from 1988 until 1990 when he ran for an 25 Alabama Senate seat and won; he has served in the Senate for nine consecutive terms since then; his combined experience 26 27 in both houses of the Alabama Legislature makes him its longest serving member; and 28

29 WHEREAS, during his legislative career, Senator 30 Waggoner has served as the Senate Minority Leader from 2002 through 2010 and as Senate Majority Leader from 2010 through 31 32 2014; Senator Waggoner currently serves on the following 33 Senate Committees: Rules, as Chair; Confirmations, as Vice Chair; Jefferson County Local Legislation, as Chair; Senator 34 35 Waggoner serves on other committees such as Banking and 36 Insurance; Finance and Taxation Education; Finance; and the 37 Joint Transportation Committee; and

38 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner is the recipient of 39 numerous awards and countless accolades, including the Ronald Reagan Lifetime Achievement Award in 2012; the 40 41 Alabama State Council of the Arts Legacy Award in 2013; the 42 Birmingham Southern College Distinguished Alumni Award in 43 2013; the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame Distinguished Alabama Sportsman Award in 2019; The University of Alabama at 44 45 Birmingham President's Medal in 2021; and the National 46 Grocers Association 2021 Spirit of America Award; and

47 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner generously gives of his experience, time, and talent to serve on service club boards 48 49 and committees, including Executive Committee of Birmingham 50 Business Alliance; Faulkner University Board of Trustees; Greater Birmingham Convention and Visitors Bureau; he holds 51 52 memberships on the Chambers of Commerce for Hoover, 53 Homewood, Shelby County, and Vestavia Hills; he is a 50-year member of Civitan International; and an active member of 54 55 Masons and Shriners organizations; he is a founding member and past president of the Birmingham Tip-Off Club; and 56
