FOR 5 PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS. 6 7 WHEREAS, with very special pleasure, we highly honor Mr. John Allison Teague, Sr. for his numerous professional 8 9 achievements; and 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Teague was born on July 9, 1944, in Childersburg, Alabama, to Mayburn and Ralph Teague; he is 11 the father of Allison, Todd, and John; the husband of Tami 12 13 Teague; and the brother of Ralph Judson, Jr. and Ashley 14 Teague; and 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Teaque graduated from Childersburg High School in 1962, attended Jacksonville State University from 16 17 1962-1963, and attended the United States Fidelity and 18 Guaranty School of Insurance in 1976; and 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Teague served as a member of the Alabama House of Representatives, representing District 55: 20 21 Talladega, Childersburg, and Calhoun Counties from 22 1974-1976; he was elected through a special election to the Alabama Senate in 1976, where he was reelected for two full 23 24 terms; he was elected as President Pro-Tempore of the Senate 25 by his peers in 1983; as President Pro-Tempore, he was given a vote on every standing committee for the fist time in 26 27 Alabama history; he was elected as the Most Outstanding Senator by his peers in 1984 and 1986; served the State of 28

Alabama Senate District 19: Talladega, St. Claire, and Calhoun Counties from 1976-1982; and served the State of Alabama Senate District 19: Talladega, Cleburne, Clay, Coosa, and Elmore Counties from 1982-1986; and

33 WHEREAS, Mr. Teague has been the recipient of many profound awards and forms of recognition, including being a 34 35 charter member of the Board of Trustees for the Alabama 36 Motorsports Hall of Fame from 1975-1987; being a member of 37 the Board of Trustees for Troy State University from 38 1980-1992, where he served on the Executive Committee and the Athletic Committee; being recognized on the cover of 39 Alabama Magazine as The Most Effective Legislator in 1984; 40 41 receiving the Lyndon Baines Johnson Political Freedom Award 42 by the Alabama Democratic Conference in 1984; being granted 43 a Doctorate of Humane Letters from Talladega College in 1984; receiving The University of Montevallo Area Public 44 45 Official of the Year Award in 1985; being named Alabama 46 Wildlife Federation's Conservationist of the Year in 1986; and being the only person in the nation to receive the 47 prestigious CIT Rebuilding America Award in 1988; in 48 49 addition, Central Alabama Community College named its first 50 ever scholarship award, The John Teague Scholarship Award, in 1984; the bridge over the Coosa River in Childersburg was 51 52 named the John A. Teague Bridge in 1987; and the Alabama 53 Legislature and Board of Trustees for the Alabama Institute for the Deaf and Blind named the student center on the 54 55 school's campus the John A. Teague Student Center in 1989; 56 and
