1 2 3 4 SJR RECOGNIZING ALABAMA'S TECHNOLOGY WORKFORCE AND ITS 5 ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE STATE. 6 7 WHEREAS, emerging technologies are driving the 8 creation of the industries of the future, and new 9 technologies are transforming every area of our lives; and 10 WHEREAS, with great pride and pleasure, we recognize Alabama's technology and the emerging technology job 11 sector's impact on the state's economy; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the resources that are invested into Alabama's technology industry and advanced, emerging 14 technologies are critical to creating the industries of the 15 future, including autonomous cars, technology manufacturing, 16 17 and algorithms for disease diagnosis; and 18 WHEREAS, Alabama's technology sector has grown with 19 more than 88,000 technology employees; technology accounts for approximately five percent of Alabama's overall 20 21 workforce; Alabama's technology sector has an estimated 22 direct economic impact of \$10.5 billion; and WHEREAS, the broad-based impact of the technology 23 24 industry touches every community, company, and industry 25 market across Alabama; and 26 WHEREAS, Alabama has seen a 57 percent increase in the number of job postings related to emerging technologies, 27 smart cities, drones, artificial intelligence, virtual and 28

29 augmented reality, and blockchain; and

30 WHEREAS, studies report that net new technology employment in Alabama will grow by nearly 2 percent, and by 31 the year 2026, net technology employment will have grown by 32 33 6.8 percent in Alabama; and 34 WHEREAS, Alabama's technology workforce has a 35 positive economic impact on the state; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 36 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Alabama's technology sector, 37 38 technology innovators, and technology job creators are 39 commended, and this resolution is dedicated to them in highest esteem and gratitude. 40
