22	has discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes;
23	to expressly provide that this act does not affect any 2024
24	session statutes; and to specify the duties of the Secretary
25	of State regarding the custody of the cumulative supplements
26	and replacement volumes.
27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1.(a) Those general and permanent laws of the



29 state enacted during the 2023 First Special Session, the 2023 30 Regular Session, and the 2023 Second Special Session as 31 contained in the 2023 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 32 15B, inclusive, Volumes 16A to 20, inclusive, and Volumes 22 33 to 22A, inclusive, and the 2023 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, 34 and 21A, and the additions and deletions made by the Code 35 Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of 36 the 2023 Cumulative Supplements and 2023 Replacement Volumes 37 16, 21, and 21A are identified and authenticated by the Great 38 39 Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of 40 each of the volumes of the cumulative supplements and upon the first inside page and the last inside page of the replacement 41 42 volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 43 1975.

64 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state 65 previously enacted and contained in the local and permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2023 66 67 First Special Session, the 2023 Regular Session, and the 2023 Second Special Session, as contained in the 2023 Cumulative 68 Supplements to Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 69 70 22J, 22K, 22L, and 22M and the additions and deletions made by 71 the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and 72 published by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which 73 volumes of the 2023 Cumulative Supplements are identified and 74 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed 75 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the 76 cumulative supplements, are adopted and incorporated into the 77 Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022. This act is a law that adopts a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in



this act shall be deemed to codify any provision of law that was adopted in violation of any provision of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, establishing requirements for, or limitations on, the enactment of a law.

89 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as the 90 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its 91 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2024 92 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, and 21A of the Code of Alabama 93 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes with the material contained in the cumulative supplements 94 95 without making substantive changes, but making, under the supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code 96 97 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may 98 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of 99 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and 100 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and 101 misspellings.

Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute enacted into law during any 2024 session of the Legislature.

105 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, the duly authenticated volumes of the 2023 Cumulative Supplements 106 107 and the 2024 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, and 21A shall be 108 transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the 109 volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes 110 shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of 111 112 State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper



113 certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or

114 parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for

115 similar services.

116 Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately.
