Senate Bill 98 as introduced would increase the administrative and financial obligations of the State Board of Education by an undetermined amount to adopt rules implementing and administering the provisions of this bill which include: (1) providing for the inspection of every school facility at least once every five years; (2) establishing and updating the criteria for school security inspections; (3) providing requirements for the selection of school security inspectors; (4) developing applications for, and awarding grants to assist local boards of education in complying with school security criteria and fire safety recommendations; and (5) developing procedures for the newly created School Security and Fire Safety Fund.

Further, this bill would increase the administrative and financial obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) by an undetermined amount to: (1) adopt rules implementing and administering the School Mapping Data Program for the purpose of collecting and disseminating mapping information of each public school to local, county, state and federal public safety agencies.
