Senate Bill 256 as introduced could increase the obligations of the State Laboratory, operated by the Department of Public Health, by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost of adding conditions on the Recommended Uniform Screening Panel (RUSP) to the state newborn screening panel, pursuant to this bill, and any requirements and/or equipment needed to implement the associated testing.
