House Bill 126 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security would increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission and the Alabama Department of Public Health to require training on interacting with individuals with sensory needs or invisible disabilities, as part of continuing education requirements for certain trainees, fire-protection personnel and certified volunteer firefighters, and emergency medical service personnel, respectively. This bill would require both agencies to collaborate with a non-profit company to administer this training and provide it without compensation.
