House Bill 126 as passed the House of Representatives would increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission and the Alabama Department of Public Health to require training on interacting with individuals with sensory needs or invisible disabilities, as part of continuing education requirements for certain recently certified fire-protection trainees, fire-protection personnel and certified volunteer firefighters, and emergency medical service personnel, respectively. This bill would require both agencies to collaborate with a non-profit company to administer this training and provide it without compensation.
