Senate Bill 155 as passed the Senate would require: (1) the Department of Revenue, rather than the Department of Transportation, to report annually to the Joint Transportation Committee both the local motor fuel excise tax revenues collected and the expenditures on road and bridge maintenance and improvement for the immediately preceding fiscal year; and (2) the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, upon request of the Committee, to meet the current reporting requirements regarding the performance of the Department of Transportation on highway construction, maintenance, and costs for the immediately preceding fiscal year. This bill would not otherwise affect state or local funding.
