House Bill 68 as introduced would increase the obligations of the Office of Information Technology by a department-estimated \$3.1 million in Fiscal Year 2025 and \$1.4 million each fiscal year thereafter by requiring the adoption of rules regarding sensitive personal information held or accessible by certain state and local government entities.

This bill would also increase the obligations of state and local government entities by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to implement security measures to protect sensitive personally identifying information against security breaches.
