House Bill 167 as passed the House of Representatives could increase the administrative obligations of the Attorney General for the enforcement of certain consumer protections regarding device filters as provided by this bill; however, these obligations may be offset by any civil penalties up to \$5,000 per violation and \$50,000 in the aggregate, attorney's fees, or investigation expenses that are recovered from violators of the provisions of this bill and retained by the Attorney General.
