House Bill 167 as reported by the Committee on Fiscal Responsibility & Economic Development could increase the administrative obligations of the Attorney General for the enforcement of certain consumer protections regarding device filters as provided by this bill; however, these obligations may be offset by any civil penalties up to \$5,000 per violation and \$50,000 in the aggregate, attorney's fees, or investigation expenses that are recovered from violators of the provisions of this bill and retained by the Attorney General.
