House Bill 44 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security could increase the obligations of certain state, county, and municipal custodial agencies by an undetermined amount dependent upon the cost to collect and maintain certain information on detainees and to notify emergency contacts upon death or serious injury of the detainee.

This bill would increase the obligations of the Bureau of Pardons and Paroles by a bureau-estimated \$100,000 annually to comply with the provisions of this bill.
