19	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
20	(a) Parents have a fundamental right to direct the
21	upbringing, education, care, and control of their children.
22	(b) This amendment may not be construed as authorizing
23	or allowing a parent to engage in child abuse or neglect.
24	Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
25	Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
26	appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
27	paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:

33 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 34 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 35 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this 36 state.

37 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 38 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 39 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 40 following description of the substance or subject matter of 41 the proposed constitutional amendment:
