1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to commercial motor vehicle drivers; to amend  
3 Section 32-9A-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to increase the  
4 intrastate air-mile radius for which the intrastate hours of  
5 service limitation applies.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 32-9A-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975,  
8 is amended to read as follows:

9 "§32-9A-6

10 (a) The intrastate hours of service ~~limitations~~  
11 limitation applied to the drivers of commercial motor vehicles  
12 operating in intrastate transportation within a ~~75~~150 air-mile  
13 radius of their normal work reporting location, following 10  
14 consecutive hours off duty except when prohibited by federal  
15 rule or law, shall be the following:

16 (1) A 12-hour driving limit, provided driving shall be  
17 prohibited for any driver of a commercial motor vehicle  
18 ~~after~~who has been on duty for ~~having been on duty for~~ more  
19 than 15 hours ~~is prohibited~~.

20 (2) Driving shall be prohibited for any driver who has  
21 been on duty 70 hours in seven consecutive days.

22 (b) An intrastate driver is defined by his or her  
23 previous seven days in operation.

24 (c) All motor carriers operating under the variance  
25 provided by this section shall have a satisfactory safety  
26 rating with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration  
27 (FMCSA) or be unrated. Subsection (a) shall not apply to a  
28 motor carrier with a conditional or unsatisfactory FMCSA

29 safety rating.

30 (d) All motor carriers operating under the variance  
31 provided by this section shall require its drivers to comply  
32 with the record of duty provisions under 49 C.F.R. ~~Section~~§  
33 395.8. The driver shall retain a copy of each record of duty  
34 status for the previous seven consecutive days, which shall be  
35 in his or her possession and available for inspection while on  
36 duty."

37 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October  
38 1, 2024.
