SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, there is an intrastate hours of service limitation applied to drivers of commercial motor vehicles operating in intrastate transportation, within a 75 air-mile radius of their normal work reporting location, following 10 consecutive hours off duty, except when prohibited by federal rule or law.

This bill would increase the air-mile radius for intrastate motor carriers from 75 to 150 to reflect the current federal allowance.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to commercial motor vehicle drivers; to amend Section 32-9A-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to increase the intrastate air-mile radius for which the intrastate hours of service limitation applies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-9A-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§32-9A-6
