#### SYNOPSIS:

Under the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, the Legislature or a county may not increase the compensation of a state or county officer during the officer's term of office by increasing or imposing new duties, nor may the Legislature or county decrease the compensation of a state or county officer during the officer's term of office.

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the Legislature to set and alter the compensation of county officers and sheriffs by general or local law, and to prohibit the Legislature from altering the compensation of a county officer or sheriff during the term of office.

  - (b) As to <u>state</u> officers who are members of any court, board, commission, or similar body whose terms do not run concurrently, any increase or decrease in the salary, fees, or other compensation of the members of <u>any such the</u> court, board, commission, or similar body shall become effective as to all <u>such</u> members thereof immediately after the expiration of the term or terms of office of the member or members whose term or terms first expire."

- (a) The Legislature, from time to time by general or local law, may fix and alter the salary or compensation of any officer of the county or any sheriff. However, any alteration in compensation of an officer of the county or sheriff who is elected or appointed for a fixed term shall not take effect until after the term for which the officer or sheriff is elected or appointed. The authority provided by this subsection shall be in addition to any other authority provided by this Constitution to fix and alter salary or compensation.
  - (b) The Legislature shall not do any of the following:



- (1) By the imposition of new, different, and additional 85 86 duties or otherwise, increase or authorize the increase of the 87 salary, fees, or other compensation of any officer of the 88 county or any sheriff who is elected or appointed for a fixed 89 term during the term for which he or she is elected or 90 appointed, regardless of whether the officer or sheriff may be 91 removed at the pleasure of the authority electing or 92 appointing him or her or only upon impeachment.
  - (2) In any manner or by any means, decrease or authorize the decrease of the salary, fees, or other compensation of any officer of the county or any sheriff during the term for which he or she is elected or appointed.

- (3) Increase or decrease or authorize the increase or decrease of the salary, fees, or other compensation of any person filling an unexpired term in any office of the county or any sheriff during the remainder of the term, either before or after the appointment or election of the person to fill the unexpired term.
- 103 (c) As to county officers who are members of any court, 104 board, commission, or similar body whose terms do not run 105 concurrently, any increase or decrease in the salary, fees, or 106 other compensation of the members of the court, board, 107 commission, or similar body shall become effective as to all 108 members thereof immediately after the expiration of the term 109 or terms of office of the member or members whose term or 110 terms first expire.
- 111 (d) This section shall not affect Article VI of the constitution.



113	Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
114	Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
115	appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
116	paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
117	change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
118	for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
119	grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
120	internal or external citations and cross-references; and

123	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
124	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
125	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this
126	state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot
127	number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the
128	election ballot and shall set forth the following description
129	of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
130	constitutional amendment:
