1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
3 of 2022, relating to Jackson County, to authorize the mayors
4 of municipalities in the county to participate in the
5 Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under the same terms
6 and conditions as other employees in the same retirement
7 system.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
10 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed and shall become valid as a
11 part of the constitution when all requirements of this act and
12 applicable constitutional provisions are fulfilled:

15 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

16 In Jackson County, the mayors of municipalities in the
17 county may participate in the Employees' Retirement System of
18 Alabama under the same terms and conditions as other employees
19 in the same retirement system. Any mayor holding office at the
20 time of the ratification of this amendment shall be eligible
21 to purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System
22 for the time the official has served in the current office. No
23 person may participate in both a supernumerary program and the
24 Employees' Retirement System based on the same service.

25 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
26 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
27 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
28 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:

29 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
30 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
31 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
32 internal or external citations and cross-references; and
33 translate effective dates.

34 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
35 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
36 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
37 of this state.

38 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
39 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
40 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
41 following description of the substance or subject matter of
42 the proposed constitutional amendment:

43 "Relating to Jackson County, proposing an amendment to
44 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the mayors
45 of municipalities in the county to participate in the
46 Employees' Retirement System of Alabama under the same terms
47 and conditions as other employees in the same retirement
48 system.

49 Proposed by Act ____."
