1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Colbert County; to further provide for the
3 compensation of the judge of probate.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. (a) Beginning with the next term of office
6 after October 1, 2024, the Judge of Probate of Colbert County
7 shall receive as his or her compensation an amount equal to 80
8 percent of the total compensation paid to a circuit judge with
9 the same number of full years of service as the judge of
10 probate, pursuant to Section 12-10B-1, Code of Alabama 1975.
11 This compensation shall be paid out of the county general fund
12 and shall be in lieu of any and all other compensation
13 provided by law.

14 (b) All fees and monies collected or received by the
15 office of the judge of probate, excluding the judge of
16 probate's compensation, shall be deposited into the county
17 general fund.

18 (c) The Judge of Probate of Colbert County shall be
19 entitled to the same cost-of-living increase percentage
20 granted to other public officials pursuant to the Omnibus Pay
21 Act.

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
23 1, 2024.
