A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to St. Clair County; providing for an additional expense allowance and salary for the coroner and deputy coroner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Commencing on October 1, 2024, the Coroner of St. Clair County shall be entitled to an additional expense allowance in the amount of five hundred twenty-five dollars (\$525) per month, which shall be in addition to all other expense allowances, compensation, or salary provided by law. This expense allowance shall be payable monthly from the general fund of the county.

(b) Beginning with the expiration of the term of the incumbent coroner, the expense allowance for the coroner provided in subsection (a) and any other expense allowance provided for the coroner prior to the effect date of this act shall be converted to salary, payable monthly from the general fund of the county and at that time subsection (a) and any other expense allowance provided to the coroner prior to the effective date of this act shall become void.

29           Section 2. (a) Commencing on October 1, 2024, the  
30 Deputy Coroner of St. Clair County shall be entitled to an  
31 additional expense allowance in the amount of two thousand six  
32 hundred dollars (\$2600) per year, which shall be in addition  
33 to all other expense allowances, compensation, or salary  
34 provided by law. This expense allowance shall be payable  
35 monthly from the general fund of the county.

36           (b) Beginning with the expiration of the term of the  
37 incumbent coroner, any expense allowance for the deputy  
38 coroner provided in subsection (a) and any other expense  
39 allowances provided for the assistant coroner or deputy  
40 coroner of the county by any names known prior to the  
41 effective date of this act shall be converted to salary and at  
42 that time subsection (a) and any other expense allowance  
43 provided to the deputy coroner or the assistant coroner shall  
44 become void. The position shall be known as the Deputy Coroner  
45 of St. Clair County and the salary shall be payable monthly  
46 from the general fund of the county

47           Section 3. This act shall become effective on October  
48 1, 2024, upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
49 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
