1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 To authorize the governing body of the City of
3 Trussville, Alabama, pursuant to Section 217 of the
4 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to increase, for public
5 school purposes, the rate at which there is levied and
6 collected by the city, on all taxable property situated within
7 the city, the ad valorem tax authorized by Section 216.04 of
8 the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and an election held in
9 the city on February 25, 2014, to a maximum rate, for any tax
10 year of the city, which is equal to \$1.99 on each one hundred
11 dollars (19.9 mills on each dollar) of assessed value.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. For the purposes of this act, the following
14 words have the following meanings:

15 (1) ALABAMA CONSTITUTION. The Constitution of Alabama
16 of 2022, as amended.

17 (2) CITY. The City of Trussville, Alabama.

18 (3) CITY COUNCIL. The City Council of the City of
19 Trussville.

20 (4) SCHOOL BOARD. The Trussville City Board of
21 Education.

22 (5) SCHOOL FUNDING PROPOSAL. The proposal to increase
23 the rate at which the Special School Tax is authorized for
24 levy and collection to a maximum rate, for any tax year of the
25 city, which is equal to \$1.99 on each one hundred dollars
26 (19.9 mills on each dollar) of assessed value, an increase of
27 up to \$1.29 on each one hundred dollars (12.9 mills on each
28 dollar) of assessed value to be used for public school



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29 purposes.

30 (6) SPECIAL SCHOOL TAX. The ad valorem tax authorized
31 by Section 216.04 of the Alabama Constitution and an election
32 held in the city on February 25, 2014, to be levied and
33 collected on taxable property in the city at the rate of \$0.70
34 on each one hundred dollars (7 mills on each dollar) of
35 assessed value.

36 Section 2. The city presently levies and collects the
37 special school tax at the rate of \$0.70 on each one hundred
38 dollars (7 mills on each dollar) of assessed value. Pursuant
39 to a resolution adopted by the city council after a public
40 hearing in accordance with Section 217(f) of the Alabama
41 Constitution, and at the request of the school board, the city
42 has made and adopted the school funding proposal.

43 Section 3. Pursuant to Section 217(f) of the Alabama
44 Constitution and a resolution adopted by the city council
45 after a public hearing, the school funding proposal is hereby
46 approved and the city council may increase the rate at which
47 the city levies and collects the special school tax to a
48 maximum rate, for any tax year, which is equal to \$1.99 on
49 each one hundred dollars (19.9 mills on each dollar) of
50 assessed value, an increase of up to 12.9 mills on each dollar
51 of assessed value to be used for public school purposes.

52 Section 4. The increase in the rate at which the
53 special school tax may be levied and collected pursuant to
54 this act is subject to the approval of a majority of the
55 qualified electors residing in the city who vote on the
56 proposed increase at a special election called and held for



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57 such purpose pursuant to the provisions of Section 217(f) of
58 the Alabama Constitution.

59 Section 5. This act shall become effective June 1,
60 2024.
