A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Lamar County; to amend Act 2023-62 of the 2023 Regular Session, now appearing as Section 45-38-81.60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, authorizing the Judge of Probate of Lamar County to set and collect a mail fee for the renewal of motor vehicle license registrations and business licenses by mail or through the Internet; to include boat license, and any other licenses deliverable by mail in the authorization for a mail fee.t

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Act 2023-62 of the 2023 Regular Session, now appearing as Section 45-38-81.60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-38-81.60

(a) The Judge of Probate of Lamar County may set and collect a mail fee from any person renewing a motor vehicle registration ~~or~~, business license, boat license, or any other license deliverable by mail or over the Internet to offset the costs of the renewal, including the costs of the mailing of the motor vehicle license decals or license plates ~~or~~, the renewed business license, the renewed boat license, or any

29 other license delivered by mail to the person renewing the  
30 registration or license. The judge of probate may set the mail  
31 fee on each transaction not to exceed five dollars (\$5). All  
32 fees authorized under this section shall be collected and  
33 deposited in a special fund in the county treasury and used at  
34 the discretion of the judge of probate for the operation of  
35 the office of the judge of probate.

36 (b) This section is supplemental to any other authority  
37 or fees of the judge of probate. This section shall not affect  
38 the option of any person to renew the registration of a motor  
39 vehicle, ~~or~~ a business license, a boat license, or any other  
40 license in person in the office of the judge of probate."

41 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
42 2024.
