5	AN ACT
6	To alter and rearrange the boundary lines and corporate
7	limits of the City of Childersburg in and the Town of Bon Air
8	in Talladega County to remove certain property from the
9	corporate limits of the Town of Bon Air and add the property
10	to the City of Childersburg.
11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
12	Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of
13	the City of Childersburg and the Town of Bon Air in Talladega
14	County are altered and rearranged to remove from the corporate
15	limits of the Town of Bon Air all of the following territory
16	and to add the territory to the City of Childersburg:
17	26.38 acre tract
18	Commence at a 1" pipe in place being the Southeast
19	corner of the Northeast one-fourth of the Southeast one-fourth
20	of Section 29, Township 20 South, Range 3 East, Talladega
21	County, Alabama; thence proceed South 00° 56' 10" West along
22	the West boundary of the Southwest one-fourth of the Southwest
23	one-fourth for a distance of 230.62 feet to a railroad rail in
24	place thence proceed North 59° 37' 32" East for a distance of
25	343.65 feet to a 5/8" capped rebar in place (Bailey), proceed
26	North 59° 22' 17" East for a distance of 299.99 feet; thence
27	proceed North 30° 40' 22" West for a distance of 725.99 feet
28	to a 5/8" capped rebar in place (Bailey), said point being

29 located on the Southerly right-of-way of Faye S. Perry Drive; thence proceed North 59° 07' 42" East along the Southerly 30 right-of-way of said road for a distance of 1081.27 feet to a 31 32 ¹/₂" rebar in place, said point being the P. C. of a concave curve left having an arc distance of 266.72 feet and a radius 33 34 of 2474.99 feet; thence proceed Northeasterly along the 35 Southerly right-of-way of said road and along the curvature of 36 said curve for a chord bearing and distance of North 55° 51' 37 49" East, 266.59 feet to the point of beginning. From this beginning point continue Northeasterly along the Southerly 38 39 right-of-way of said Faye S. Perry Drive and the curvature of a concave curve left having an arc distance of 346.58 feet and 40 a radius of 2472.99 feet for a chord bearing and distance of 41 North 48° 45' 53" east, 346.30 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar in place; 42 43 thence proceed South 38° 49' 16" East for a distance of 1151.26 feet to a ¹/₂" rebar in place; thence proceed South 34° 44 16' 12" East for a distance of 234.25 feet; thence proceed 45 South 57° 16' 18" West for a distance of 250.09 feet; thence 46 47 proceed South 34° 16' 13" East for a distance of 207.72 feet 48 to a point on the Northerly right-of-way of Lower Bon Air 49 Road; thence proceed South 60° 10' 49" West along the 50 Northerly right-of-way of said Lower Bon Air Road for a distance of 297.25 feet to a ¹/₂ rebar in place; thence proceed 51 North 44° 30' 42" West for a distance of 50.68 feet; thence 52 proceed North 65° 16' 45" West for a distance of 47.39 feet; 53 thence proceed North 40° 33' 27" West for a distance of 68.20 54 feet; thence proceed North 34° 42' 53" West for a distance of 55 56 60.96 feet to a ¹/₂" rebar in place; thence proceed South 55°

17' 47" West for a distance of 188.86 feet to a ½" rebar in 57 place; thence proceed North 28° 48' 29" West for a distance of 58 59 23.23 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " rebar in place (CA #0114); thence proceed South 61° 14' 48" West for a distance of 200.00 feet to a 1/2" 60 rebar in place (CA #0114); thence proceed South 28° 48' 29" 61 62 East for a distance of 52.81 feet; thence proceed North 81° 63 08' 06" West for a distance of 300.44 feet; thence proceed 64 North 00° 20' 48" East for a distance of 1342.45 feet to the 65 point of beginning.

The above described land is located in the Southeast one-fourth of the Northwest one-fourth, the Northeast one-fourth of the Southwest one-fourth and the Southeast one-fourth of the Southwest one-fourth of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 3 East, Talladega County, Alabama and contains 26.38 acres.

Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing the proposed territory to be removed from the Town of Bon Air and added to the City of Childersburg is on file and open to public inspection in the Office of the Judge of Probate in Talladega County.
