A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to Jefferson County; to authorize persons employed by the county whose duties include the investigation, prosecution, and enforcement of county ordinance violations or any local laws of the county to be designated as peace officers under certain conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In Jefferson County, any persons employed by the county whose duties include the investigation, prosecution, and enforcement of county ordinance violations or any local law of the county may be designated by his or her appointing authority as a peace officer in this state with the authority to execute warrants on persons charged by a warrant lawfully issued or by other lawful process with a violation of a county ordinance or local law. Any person designated as peace officer shall meet the minimum standards for law enforcement officers and shall hold a current certification from the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission. The person designated as a peace officer under this section shall have the same protection as a deputy sheriff in this state.
