1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Walker County; to provide for the salary of
4 the judge of probate.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1. (a) Effective January 20, 2025, the Judge of
7 Probate of Walker County shall receive an annual salary equal
8 to the first step of the state base salary paid to a state
9 district court judge at that time.

10 (b) In addition, the judge of probate shall be entitled
11 to any increases in salary, including step increases and
12 cost-of-living increases, in the same amount and the same
13 manner as a district judge having the same number of years of
14 service that the judge of probate has after that date.

15 (c) The salary provided by this section shall be in
16 lieu of any and all other prior compensation or salary
17 provided by law to the judge of probate.

18 (d) The salary shall be paid in equal periodic
19 installments from the general fund of the county.

20 (e) Any new judge of probate first elected or appointed
21 after January 20, 2025, to his or her first term shall revert
22 to the first step of the state base salary paid to a district
23 court judge and the salary shall be adjusted as provided in
24 subsection (b).

25 Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
26 20, 2025.
