11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
12	Section 1. (a) Effective January 20, 2025, the Judge of
13	Probate of Walker County shall receive an annual salary equal
14	to the first step of the state base salary paid to a state
15	district court judge at that time.
16	(b) In addition, the judge of probate shall be entitled
17	to any increases in salary, including step increases and
18	cost-of-living increases, in the same amount and the same
19	manner as a district judge having the same number of years of
20	service that the judge of probate has after that date.
21	(c) The salary provided by this section shall be in
22	lieu of any and all other prior compensation or salary
23	provided by law to the judge of probate.
24	(d) The salary shall be paid in equal periodic
25	installments from the general fund of the county.
26	(e) Any new judge of probate first elected or appointed
27	after January 20, 2025, to his or her first term shall revert
