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1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Marion County; to amend Sections 45-47-230
3 and 45-47-242.21, Code of Alabama 1975, to abolish certain
4 expense allowances paid to certain county officials; to revise
5 the salaries of the sheriff, revenue commissioner, and members
6 of the county commission; and to repeal Section 45-47-70, Code
7 of Alabama 1975, relating to expense allowances paid to
8 members of the Marion County Commission.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Sections 45-47-230 and 45-47-242.21, Code of
11 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

12 "§45-47-230

13 (a) The County Commission of Marion County is
14 authorized and directed to pay the chief deputy sheriff, each
15 deputy sheriff, and the sheriff's clerk an additional expense
16 allowance of one hundred dollars (\$100) per month payable from
17 the general fund of the county. The expense allowance shall be
18 in addition to all compensation or allowances heretofore
19 payable to each such officer.

20 ~~(b) The Sheriff of Marion County shall be entitled to~~
21 ~~receive an expense allowance in the amount of five hundred~~
22 ~~dollars (\$500) per month and each~~ Each deputy sheriff of
23 Marion County shall be entitled to receive an expense
24 allowance of fifty dollars (\$50) per month to be paid out of
25 the county general fund. This expense allowance shall be in
26 addition to any and all other compensation, salary, and
27 expense allowances provided for by law. The expense allowance
28 shall be paid out of the General Fund of Marion County."

30 (a) The judge of probate is relieved of all duties and
31 responsibilities relating to the assessment and collection of
32 taxes, commissions, and issuance fees on motor vehicles. The
33 revenue commissioner shall receive the commissions and fees
34 currently allocated to the judge of probate for performing
35 these functions, and those fees and commissions shall be
36 remitted to the county general fund. Reporting and remitting
37 the collections of those fees shall be made by the revenue
38 commissioner or as otherwise required by law.

39 (b) The Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall
40 perform all duties relating to the issuance of motor vehicle
41 license plates in the county and shall perform all duties
42 relating to the assessment and collection of ad valorem taxes,
43 commissions, fees, or other charges imposed by law on motor
44 vehicles, which have heretofore been performed jointly by the
45 revenue commissioner and the judge of probate.

46 ~~(c) The Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall be~~
47 ~~compensated an additional five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per~~
48 ~~year, paid in equal monthly installments from the general fund~~
49 ~~of the county, for performing all of the duties relating to~~
50 ~~the assessments, collections, and issuance of motor vehicle~~
51 ~~license plates in Marion County."~~

52 Section 2. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
53 act, the Sheriff of Marion County shall receive an additional
54 expense allowance in an amount that brings his or her total
55 compensation to eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) per year to
56 be paid out of the county general fund. The expense allowance



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57 shall be in addition to any and all other compensation,
58 salary, or expense allowances provided by law.

59 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
60 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and the
61 Sheriff of Marion County shall receive a total yearly salary
62 of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), which shall be in lieu
63 of any other compensation, salary, or expense allowance
64 provided by law for the sheriff for the performance of his or
65 her official duties.

66 Section 3. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
67 act, the Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall receive
68 an additional expense allowance in an amount that brings his
69 or her total compensation to seventy-two thousand dollars
70 (\$72,000) per year to be paid out of the county general fund.
71 The expense allowance shall be in addition to any and all
72 other compensation, salary, or expense allowances provided by
73 law.

74 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
75 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and the
76 Revenue Commissioner of Marion County shall receive a total
77 yearly salary of seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000), which
78 shall be in lieu of any other compensation, salary, or expense
79 allowance provided by law for the revenue commissioner for the
80 performance of his or her official duties. The compensation
81 provided by Section 11-2A-3, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be
82 considered to be included in the total yearly salary.

83 Section 4. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
84 act, each member of the Marion County Commission shall receive



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85 an additional expense allowance in an amount that brings the
86 total compensation of each member to sixty thousand dollars
87 (\$60,000) per year to be paid out of the county general fund.
88 The expense allowance shall be in addition to any and all
89 other compensation, salary, or expense allowances provided by
90 law.

91 (b) Beginning with the next term of office, the expense
92 allowance provided in subsection (a) shall be void, and each
93 member of the Marion County Commission shall receive a total
94 yearly salary of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), which shall
95 be in lieu of any other compensation, salary, or expense
96 allowance provided by law for the members for the performance
97 of their official duties.

98 Section 5. Section 45-47-70, Code of Alabama 1975,
99 relating to expense allowances paid to members of the Marion
100 County Commission, is repealed.

101 Section 6. This act shall become effective on June 1,
102 2024.
