HJR___ NAMING THE PORTION OF ALABAMA STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 157 BETWEEN MILE MARKERS 40 AND 41 IN LAWRENCE COUNTY, ALABAMA, THE WILLIAM HOWELL ROGERS, SR. MEMORIAL MILE.

WHEREAS, it is with the highest accolade that this body honors the memory of William Howell "Skip" Rogers, Sr. by requesting the Department of Transportation designate the portion of Alabama State Highway Route 157 between mile markers 40 and 41 in Lawrence County, Alabama, as the William Howell Rogers, Sr. Memorial Mile; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, having served in the United States Air Force from 1951 to 1955; after completing his military service, he continued to have the calling to serve others and earned a Bachelor of Science in Commerce and Business Administration followed by a Juris Doctor from The University of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers established himself in the practice of law working at Thiokol in Huntsville for several years before beginning his private practice in Moulton, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers served the City of Moulton for more than 50 years as its City Attorney and as City Judge; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rogers was also a dedicated servant of
