WHEREAS, Mrs. Robinson moved to Talladega when her husband accepted a position as Pastor of Greater Ebenezer Baptist Church; she became employed as a teacher in the Talladega City and County School Systems, where she served until her retirement after 35 years; she was passionate about educating children and found joy in helping them reach their fullest potential; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Robinson has been honored by a proclamation presented by Talladega Mayor Ashton Hall and Councilwoman Vickey Robinson Hall in appreciation for the positive influence that she has had on her community; and
