WHEREAS, we take great pride and pleasure in
congratulating the Jackson High School Aggies basketball
team on winning the 2024 Alabama High School Athletic
Association 4A (AHSAA) Class 4A State Boys Basketball
Championship; and

WHEREAS, nearly 40 years after Jackson's first trip
to the final four, the Aggies captured the program's first
ever state championship; and

WHEREAS, Jackson defeated American Christian Academy
56-43 in the Class 4A Boys final at Legacy Arena in
Birmingham; the Aggies finished the season with senior guard
Micah Caster scoring seven three-pointers and finishing with
30 points on his way to Most Valuable Player honors; and

WHEREAS, Jackson was the top-ranked team in Class 4A
for much of the season but struggled offensively in the
first half of the final game; the Aggies trailed ACA 26-22
at halftime, but Caster's three-pointers in the third
quarter helped spark momentum in front of an impressive
crowd; the Jackson Aggies finished the year with a 30-2
overall record, and Caster being named MVP; and

WHEREAS, Jackson's head coach Anthony Hayes was
