WHEREAS, Daughter of Zion Ministries, Incorporated,
(DZM) a 501(c)(3) organization, was launched on November 9,
2019, to enrich, empower, and serve God's people through the
preaching of the Gospel and through ministry outreach
initiatives; and

a spiritual guide through the life milestones of those in

blankets to nursing homes and contributes to coat drives for
underprivileged youths; throughout the year, they reach out
