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4	HR ESTABLISHING A LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION TO STUDY
5	K-12 SCHOOL EDUCATION FUNDING.
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7	WHEREAS, On April 30, 2024, the Governor signed
8	SJR61, enacted as Act 2024-128, requiring the Legislature of
9	Alabama to conduct a study on modernizing K-12 education
10	funding; and
11	WHEREAS, Act 2024-128 provides compelling reasons
12	that justify the need for a legislative study on modernizing
13	K-12 education funding, including a need for greater
14	flexibility in the coordination of state education funding
15	priorities with the local needs of students, teachers, and
16	administrators, and whether this need could be better served
17	by transitioning from a resource-based funding model to one
18	that is student-based and provides greater flexibility; and
19	WHEREAS, this body finds that the members of the Ways
20	and Means Education Standing Committee of the House of
21	Representatives, along with members of the Finance and
22	Taxation Education Standing Committee of the Senate, are in
23	the best position to undertake this study; now therefore,
24	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
25	LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Legislative Study
26	Commission on Modernizing K-12 School Education Funding is
27	created to study modernizing the current K-12 school funding

28 model.

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29	(a) The Legislative Study Commission on Modernizing
30	K-12 School Education Funding shall be comprised of all
31	members of the House of Representatives Ways and Means
32	Education Standing Committee, along with all members of the
33	Senate Finance and Taxation Education Standing Committee

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- (b) The legislative study commission shall focus on the possibility of transitioning from a resource-based model of education funding to a model that provides greater flexibility and is based on the specific needs of students. The work of the legislative study commission may include, but not be limited to:
- 40 (1) Studying the projected costs and budget impact of 41 a transition.
- (2) Studying the associated changes in the tax and revenue framework that may be required to fund and maintain 43 44 a transition.
- 45 (3) Studying the changes in law required to adopt a 46 model of student-based education funding.
- (4) If a specific pathway to modernize education 47 48 school funding is endorsed by the legislative study 49 commission, developing proposed legislation to effect the 50 transition.
- (c) The chair of the House of Representatives Ways 51 and Means Education Standing Committee shall serve as a 52 53 cochair along with the chair of the Senate Finance and 54 Taxation Education Standing Committee. Meetings shall be held at the call of either cochair as necessary to conduct 55 56 business.



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57	(d) The Fiscal Division of the Legislative Services
58	Agency, the Clerk of the House of Representatives, and the
59	Secretary of the Senate shall provide administrative and
60	other assistance for the work of the legislative study
61	commission as necessary.

- (e) Pursuant to Section 36-14-17.1, Code of Alabama 1975, the Legislative Study Commission on Modernizing K-12 School Education Funding shall provide to the Secretary of State a notice of all meetings, the name of each member serving on the legislative study commission, and a copy of all reports and written recommendations produced throughout the duration of the legislative study commission.
- (f) Members of the legislative study commission shall be entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the legislative study commission pursuant to Section 49 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
- (g) The Legislative Study Commission on Modernizing K-12 School Education Funding shall prepare a report of its findings, conclusions, and recommendations for any proposed legislation, as it deems appropriate, to the Legislature no later than February 1, 2025, at which time the legislative study commission shall stand dissolved and discharged of any future duties.

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
