7 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the 8 death of Sallie Bell Ephraim McMillan of Birmingham, 9 Alabama, on February 10, 2024, at the age of 98; and 10 WHEREAS, her departure leaves a void in the lives of 11 her loving family, many friends, and the community where she

13 WHEREAS, Sallie Bell Ephraim McMillan was born on 14 April 13, 1925, in Camden, Alabama, to Daniel and Pearlie 15 Ephraim; she was the eighth of nine children born into the joyful home of her loving parents and was predeceased by all 16 of her siblings; she was a 1944 graduate of Camden Academy 17 18 and matriculated to and graduated from Knoxville College; 19 she became a teacher and taught at various schools in 20 Alabama, including Canton Bend in Wilcox County, Pittman 21 Junior High School and Westfield High School in Jefferson 22 County, and R.R.
