(b) Before making a site development grant, the 23 authority shall make both of the following findings: 24

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25 (1) The site is comprised of at least 75 contiguous acres, provided that in addition to the 75 contiguous 26 27 acres, other proximate but noncontiguous property may 28 be a part of the site. 29 (2) The application includes proof that the grant funds that are approved by the authority will be 30 matched by funds on hand with, or contingently 31 committed to, the applicant such that one of the 32 33 following is true: a. If the site is located in a targeted county with a 34 35 population of less than 12,000, for every dollar of grant funds, the applicant will contribute twenty-five 36 cents (\$0.25) of additional funds. 37 38 b. If the site is located in a targeted county with a 39 population of 12,000 or greater but less than 60,000, 40 for every dollar of grant funds, the applicant will contribute fifty cents (\$0.50) of additional funds. 41 c. If the site is located in a county with a 42 population of 60,000 or greater but less than 150,000, 43 44 for every dollar of grant funds, the applicant will contribute seventy-five cents (\$0.75) of additional 45 46 funds. d. If the site is located in a county with a 47

48 population of 150,000 or greater, for every dollar of

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49	grant funds, the applicant will contribute one dollar

51	(c) The authority may impose additional requirements
