4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, termination dates are
6	established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies
7	are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset
8	Committee. After the review process is completed, the
9	committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies
10	to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which
11	either continue, terminate, or continue with
12	modification each agency reviewed.
13	This bill would provide for the continuance of
14	the Board of Heating, Air Conditioning, and
15	Refrigeration Contractors until October 1, 2028.

19	TO BE ENTITLED
20	AN ACT

22	Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
23	existence and functioning of the Board of Heating, Air
24	Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors until October 1,
25	2028.
26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
27	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
28	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of



Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors untilOctober 1, 2028.

31 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Board 32 of Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors, 33 created and functioning pursuant to Chapter 31 of Title 34, 34 Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections 35 are expressly preserved.

36 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 37 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in 38 Sections 1 and 2.

39 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,40 2024.
