SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Alabama Real Estate Appraisers Board until October 1, 2028.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Alabama Real Estate Appraisers Board until October 1, 2028.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama Real Estate Appraisers Board until October 1, 2028.

29           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama  
30 Real Estate Appraisers Board, created and functioning pursuant  
31 to Chapter 27A of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued  
32 until October 1, 2028, and those code sections are expressly  
33 preserved.

34           Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
35 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
36 Sections 1 and 2.

37           Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
