SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the State Licensing Board for General Contractors until October 1, 2027.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the State Licensing Board for General Contractors until October 1, 2027.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State Licensing Board for General Contractors until October 1, 2027.

29           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the State  
30 Licensing Board for General Contractors, created and  
31 functioning pursuant to Chapter 8 of Title 34, Code of Alabama  
32 1975, is continued until October 1, 2027, and those code  
33 sections are expressly preserved.

34           Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
35 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
36 Sections 1 and 2.

37           Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
