4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, termination dates are
6	established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies
7	are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset
8	Committee. After the review process is completed, the
9	committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies
10	to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which
11	either continue, terminate, or continue with
12	modification each agency reviewed.
13	This bill would provide for the continuance of
14	the Alabama Board of Examiners in Psychology until
15	October 1, 2028.

26	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the

27 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama 28 Board of Examiners in Psychology until October 1, 2028.

29	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama
30	Board of Examiners in Psychology, created and functioning
31	pursuant to Chapter 26 of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, is
32	continued, and those code sections are expressly preserved.
33	Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
3 4	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
35	Sections 1 and 2.
